LET'S TALK FINANCE

The Student Services team are here to help ensure that you are aware of all of the available funding, including student support loans, bursaries, trusts and scholarships as well as accessing benefits you may be entitled to.

Full-Time Further Education (Up to Level 3), Traineeships, Apprenticeships and Higher Level Apprenticeships are usually free of charge*. Fees apply for Higher Education courses such as HNC, Foundation and Honours Degrees and these fees are available on the course page on the South West College website. This page will also outline any costs such as equipment or uniform that you may require.

Some avenues may be available to ease the costs of your educational journey:

EMA (Educational Maintenance Award)

Students aged between 16 and 19 on or before 2 July 2026 and 1 July 2027 and studying a Full-Time Further Education course may be eligible to receive £30 per week. This allowance is a means-tested award based on household income. More information is available by scanning the QR code to the right:



Bus Pass

Students aged under 19 on 1st July 2026 who are studying on a Full-Time Further Education course and living at least 3 miles from the college, with no closer college offering a similar course, may be eligible for a travel award.

Care to Learn scheme

If you're a parent aged between 16 and 20 and studying at a further education college, the Care to Learn (NI) Scheme could help towards your childcare costs. You can apply for financial help if you expect to become a parent during your course.

Further Education Grant Full-Time

The Education Authority offers a limited number of Further Education Grants each year for full-time and part-time courses for students undertaking courses up to and including level 3. You can find out more here: <https://www.eani.org.uk/fegrants>

HIGHER EDUCATION FEES

Tuition fees at South West College are significantly lower than at universities. These fees cover the cost of your tuition, registration and exams. With lower tuition fees, the chance to live at home, work part-time and reduce travel costs, studying a Higher Education course is a fantastic way to gain internationally recognised qualifications close to home. Students starting university or college can apply for loans to help with their tuition fees and living costs. How much money you get depends on whether you study full-time or part-time and on your living circumstances.

All Higher Education students should apply online at www.studentfinanceni.co.uk to determine the level of maintenance grant, maintenance loan and/or tuition fees loan that are available to them. - ✓ The courses within this prospectus are categorised by level. Further Education courses include recreational courses, Diplomas, NVQs and Certificates. Higher Education courses include HNCs, HNDs, Foundation Degrees and Honours Top-Up Degrees and Higher Level Apprenticeships.
- ✓ We also offer a range of courses suitable for businesses to help you retrain or up-skill in your area of work.
- ✓ Applications are now accepted. Please do not wait until your results are available. SWC can only accommodate a limited number of applications per course.
- ✓ Applying for a course does not guarantee a place on that course. Under normal circumstances, applicants are given a formal interview before enrolment.
- ✓ Receipt of your application form will be formally acknowledged via an e-mail from the College Admissions Team.
- ✓ If you are successful at the application stage and are enrolled on a course, you will be provided with all the relevant course information, including timetables, at a general course induction session in September.

ENTRY LEVEL TO DEGREE EDUCATION

SWC provides students with a learning experience through the delivery of a wide range of level 1-6 vocational qualifications that are designed specifically to develop your technical competence as well as giving you real world experience.

LEVEL SIX	A Level Six Qualification is the equivalent of a full Bachelors Degree. In recent years there has been a surge in popularity for those who want to gain their Degree or HLA on their doorstep.
LEVEL FIVE	Level Five qualifications are the equivalent of the second year of a Bachelors Degree. HNDs, Foundation Degrees and most HLAs are Level 5 qualifications.
LEVEL FOUR	A Level Four qualification is equivalent to the first year of a degree. This is considered 'Higher Education' as it is aimed at those aged 18+. Examples of Level Four courses are HNCs.
LEVEL THREE	Level Three qualifications are equivalent to A-Levels. BTEC, Diplomas, Apprenticeships and the Access Diploma are examples of Level Three courses.
LEVEL TWO	Level Two qualifications are the equivalent of GCSEs. BTECs, Diplomas, Awards, Certificates, NVQs, Traineeships and Apprenticeships are available in Level Two.
LEVEL ONE	No formal qualifications are required for Level One courses. Examples of Level One programmes are Skills for Life and Work and some NVQs.
ENTRY LEVEL	If you want to gain a qualification that is recognised across the UK, but don't feel ready for GCSEs or equal qualifications, or you haven't studied in a long time, an Entry Level qualification could be for you.

SCHOLARSHIPS & BURSARIES AT SWC

The College has a number of scholarship initiatives which full-time students can apply for within the academic year. If you would like to find out further details, please contact your course tutor.

The Strickland Scholarship

The Strickland Scholarship is a prestigious annual bursary scheme organised by South West College, in conjunction with Strickland. The scheme will provide bursaries to students undertaking an Honours Degree/Foundation Degree or HND/C in Engineering at South West College.

Value: £2,500 each.

SSE Airtricity Scholarship

The SSE Renewables Scholarship is a third level scholarship programme funded by the SSE Renewables Regional Fund for three wind farms. The value of the award is equivalent to 50% of the course tuition fee (approx. £2,700 for Full-Time students) Visit website for courses deemed eligible by SSE Renewables and further T&Cs. Applicants must also have a home address in Co. Tyrone, Co. Derry-Londonderry, Co. Fermanagh or Co. Donegal.

SWC Higher Education Community Scholarship Scheme

As part of the College's Widening Access and Participating Plan, the College offers five scholarships to pupils from local feeder schools. The scholarships are awarded as a fee waiver for full-time courses in Computing, Visual Media Arts, Construction or Sport, over three years.

Value: Up to £10,400 over three years.

CITB NI Built Environment Award

CITB NI offers a bursary worth £1,000 to encourage more school leavers to consider a career in construction and undertake a third level Built Environment related qualification.

The bursary is aimed at first year full-time students and is intended to assist with the cost of their training. (Terms & Conditions apply) A key eligibility requirement is successful completion of a level 2 or level 3 Construction-related BTEC.

Institute of Civil Engineers QUEST Scholarship

The Institution of Civil Engineers Quest Technician Scholarship is available to students on further or higher education courses that could lead to becoming a qualified ICE technician member. Gary Bennett Scholarship

The Gary Bennett Scholarship will be awarded annually to the top-performing student who wishes to study the Open University Bachelor of Engineering Honours or Foundation Degree in Building Services with Sustainable Energy at South West College. The BlueMac Scholarship

The BlueMAC Scholarship is offered to three SWC apprentices in conjunction with BlueMAC Manufacturing. Bursaries are offered to one apprentice who has completed Year One of the Level Three Gold Apprenticeship in Engineering and to two apprentices who have completed Year One of the Higher Level Apprenticeship in Manufacturing Engineering at South West College (Dungannon Campus).

Powerscreen Scholarship

The Powerscreen Scholarship is offered to three SWC apprentices in conjunction with Terex. Bursaries are offered to one apprentice who has completed Year One of the Higher Level Apprenticeship in Manufacturing Engineering and to two apprentices who have completed Year One of the Gold Apprenticeship in Engineering at South West College (Dungannon Campus).

LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP PHARMACY SERVICES

Level 2

The Pearson BTEC Level 2 Certificate in the Principles and Practice for Pharmacy Support Staff is for learners who work in, or who are intending to work in, the role of pharmacy support staff within a pharmacy setting and want to achieve the requirements for the education and training of pharmacy support staff as set out by the General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC). 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Art, Design & Photography

A career in art and design is creative, expressive and constantly evolving. It allows individuals to turn ideas into visual outcomes across areas such as graphic design, illustration, fashion, fine art and digital media. Artists and designers use imagination alongside technical skills to communicate messages, solve problems and inspire audiences. With opportunities to work independently or within creative industries, a career in art and design encourages innovation, personal style and lifelong learning in a dynamic and competitive field.

TRAINEESHIP IN ART AND DESIGN SKILLS

Level 3

This course is one year, on which you will have four units (A 1 Skills Development, A2 Art and Design Project, B1 Personal Development and C1 Responding to a Creative Brief) and study Illustration, branding & advertising, digital imaging and film & sound. You will put together a portfolio of work for progression and explore interview techniques and practice presentation skills. You will choose your own specialist subject for the Responding to a Creative Brief Project and using the theme provided, produce a series of outcomes which are displayed in an exhibition of student work, organised by the students.

This is only a one-year course and is subject to student numbers, there is a possibility of topping up to Year 2 subject to student numbers. 


